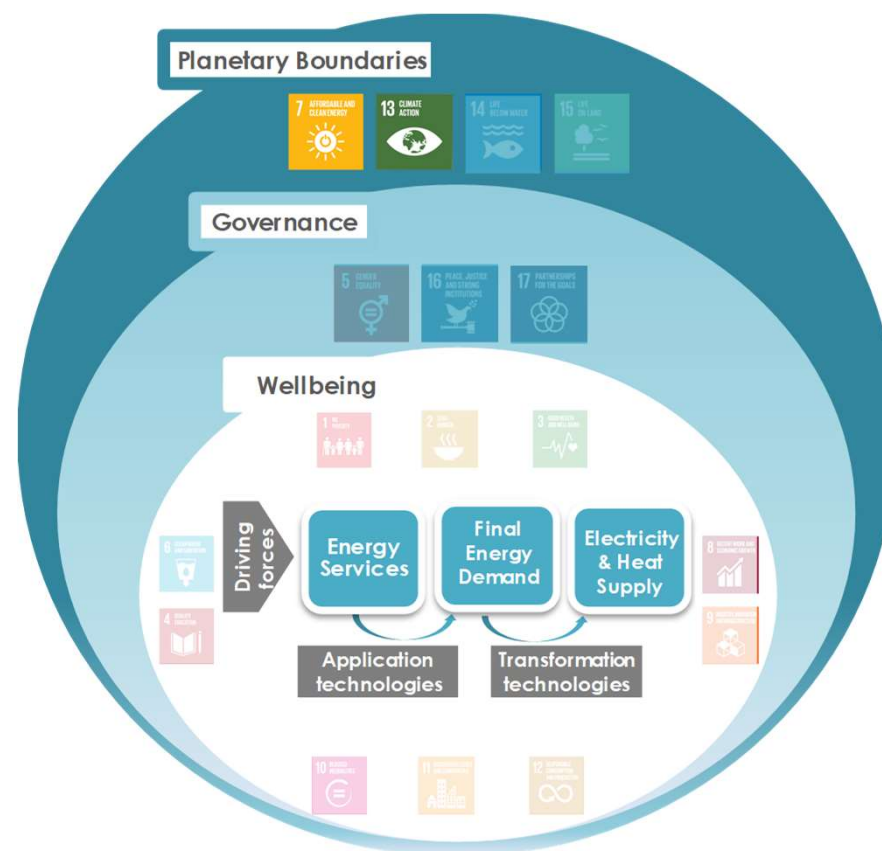

Climate and Energy Policy Indicators for monitoring Sustainable Development (I)

- design of indicators that emphasise the role of energy services for welfare;
- covering all three dimensions of sustainable development & five sectors;
- focus on interdependencies & monitoring policy progress;
- inclusion of the social dimension to add cross-cutting issues like gender and equity, quality of work and quality of life, participation and inclusion.



Climate and Energy Policy Indicators for monitoring Sustainable Development (II)

- SDGs require a systemic perspective;
- Focussing on individual targets is insufficient/misleading;
- Assessment of interlinkages requires additional information and indicators;
- CIEP provides extensive climate & energy indicators and indices that condense information and show trends and progress;
- Consideration of trade-offs and synergies is crucial.
